

Die Gänsemagd by Micha Klein

Fingerless with cable and sewn buttons

It is knitted in rounds from the wrist cuff to the fingers. The chart is the same for the left and right hand cuffs.

The pattern is tightly through the cable.

Size

7-8 (hand circumference ca. 17-20 cm) with 68 st

The width may vary by using a needle thickness higher or lower.

bigger with 72 st = (needle 1/3 knit 18. st), (needle 2/4 before 1. st 1 knit st)

smaller with 64 st = (needle 1/3 no 17. st), (needle 2/4 no 1. st)

Material

100 grams sockyarn 4-ply (100 g = 420 m length)

double pointed needles (dnp) 2,25 mm (when loosely knit) or 2,5 mm (if knit tightly)

stitchmarker, stitchholder, scissors, woolneedle for sewing, buttons, crochet hook 2-2,5 mm

Pattern

ribbing

cable



Cuff

68 st cast on (per needle 17 st)

knit 12 rounds cuff ribbing (Chart 1a + 1b)

Hand

Chart 1a+1b = knit 14 rounds cable for the hand

knit 17 rounds cable for the hand with increase for thumb gusset (9x each 2. round) = 86 st

knit 10 rounds cable for the hand, without increase for thumb gusset

knit 1 round cable with slip 2 x 9 st from thumb on stitchholder = 68 st

Chart 2 = knit 10 rounds cable without knitting thumb st

knit 1 round cable with decrease = 64 st

Changing color thread !

knit 1 round cable with decrease = 60 st

knit 5 round ribbing without thumb stitches

If you want fingerless longer, knit more rounds with cable.

Stitches bind off (knit/purl)





Picot-Crochet border on cuffs

with crochet hook 2-2,5 mm firm chrochet st, *3 chain st (working into chain spaces), slip st, 1 st pass by (the cuff should be elastic), crochet a firm crochet st into the second st * (at * repeat)

The „three drop of blood,, in the cable pattern are embroidered in kitchener stitch. “
