



„Easy Cosy – Cap for Teapot“ by Micha Klein (Wolletraum)

super bulky (50 grams = 35 meters) / 100 % wool
 needle 7 mm (when loosely knit, or 2.5 mm if knit tightly)
 10 x 10 centimeter ~ ca. 11 stitches x 14 row
 dimensions for a teapot ca. 47 centimeter for 1 bis 2 litre
 width = ca. 60 centimeters im (measured in the lower cuff)
 height = ca. 17 centimeters

You need:

1 x double pointed needles 7 mm (If you prefer to knit so.)
 1 x circular needle 7 mm
 1 x crochet needle 7 mm

Tip: Use a stitch marker at the beginning of the round.



Beginning with the lower cuff:

circular needle 7 mm

62 stitches

1 edge stitch at the beginning and end of the row

edge stitch= the last stitch slip like purl (yarn in front) / the first stitch knit

between the edge stitch: 2 st knit, 2 st purl / repeat

6 row, then halve (31 stitches / 31 stitches) and use a stitch marker

now stocking stitch

first 31 stitches: **Chart 1**



knit the first 31 stitches (**Chart 1**), then knit the remaining 31 stitches exactly the same

Chart 1 (Chart shows only Right Side. On Wrong Side work stitches as they appear.)

circular needle or double pointed needle 7 mm (31 stitches)

Legend:

	knit
	no stitch
R	edge stitch
/	k 2 tog = knit two stitches together
\	ssk = slip, slip knit - slip the two sts separately knitwise, insert the left-hand needle point through the fronts of the slopped stitchem the left, and knit them together from this position
2 st k	2 st knit
2 st p	2 st purl
1 edge stitch	the last stitch slip like purl (yarn in front) / the first stitch knit
stri	to knit
li-stri	purlwise
re-stri	knitwise
bo	bind off

the instructions as text:

62 stitches / circular needle 7 mm

1 edge st k, 2 st k, 2 st p, 1 edge st k (first row knit, next row purl slip)

6 row – knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches (edge stitch – see legend)

knit the first 31 stitches

now stocking stitch

1. row: 1 edge st k, 29 st k, 31. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

2. row: 1 edge st k, 29 st p, 31. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

3. row: 1 edge st k, 29 st k, 31. M st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

4. row: 1 edge st k, 29 st p, 31. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

5. row: 1 edge st k, 7 st k, ssk, 11 st k, k 2 tog, 7 st k, 1 edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

6. row: 1 edge st k, 27 st p, 29. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

7. row: 1 edge st k, 27 st k, 29. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

8. row: 1 edge st k,, 27 st p, 29. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

9. row: 1 edge st k, 7 st k, ssk, 9 st k, k 2 tog, 7 st k, 1 edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

10. row: 1 edge st k, 25 st p, 27. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

11. row: 1 edge st k, 25 st k, 27. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

12. row: 1 edge st k, 25 st p, 27. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

13. row: 1 edge st k, 7 st k, ssk, 7 st k, k 2 tog, 7 st k, 1 edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

14. row: 1 edge st k, 23 st p, 25. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

15. row: 1 edge st k, 7 st k, ssk, 5 st k, k 2 tog, 7 st k, 1 edge st purlwise (yarn in front), turn

16. row: 1 edge st k, 21 st p, 23. st edge st purlwise (yarn in front)

Leave stitches on holder. Knit the second half as the first half, then connect both parts and continue knitting in the round.

17. row: ssk - repeat 4 x, 3 st k, k 2 tog - repeat 4 x,
ssk - repeat 4 x, 3 st k, k 2 tog - repeat 4 x

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18. row: 26 st p

19. row: ssk - repeat 2 x , 1 st k, k 2 tog - repeat 2 x
ssk - repeat 2 x , 1 st k, k 2 tog - repeat 2 x

20. row: 14 st p

the 14 st bind off

The open side of the teapot (the neck and the handle, not the cuff of the cap) crochet with crab stitch (crochet needle 7 mm).

When I sit outside and drink tea, despite my teapot warmer can cool down quickly by the wind - therefore had now fast a simple cap here ;-)

Depending on the warmer I use, I can flap the warmer at the edge upwards so that the heat of the warmers can pull off better.
