



„Die Gänsemagd“ by Micha Klein (Wolletraum) - (update 06.2014)

4-ply Sockyarn (100 grams = 420 meters), Needle 2,25 mm (when loosely knit, or 2.5 mm if knit tightly) for German size 39. The length of the foot is adjustable. To change sizes, knit with smaller or larger needle.

Tip: Use a stitch marker at the beginning of the round.

Cuff: Chart 1

68 stitches / 17 stitches per Needle = Knit 12 rounds

Tip: Without crochet-border on cuff, the first round all stitches knit or all stitches purl.

Little Heart-Heel: **Chart 3** (you can also knit another heel)

Needle 1+4 = 34 stitches + 2 Edge stitches = 36 stitches total / Knit 32 Rounds

Chart 3 (Begin with Needle 4)

Chart shows only Right Side. On Wrong Side work stitches as they appear.

R	Edge stitch
3h \ 3v	Place 3 stitches on cable needle and let hang in front of work, knit next 3 stitches, knit 3 stitches from cable needle.
+1	1 Masche aus dem Quersfaden aufnehmen und rechts verschränkt stricken

Heel Turn:

Right Side Row: Knit 19 sts,
 knit two together through back loop,
 knit 1,
 leave 14 unworked,
 turn

Wrong Side Row: 14 stitches remain on right needle,
 Slip 1,
 purl 3,
 purl 2 together,
 purl 1,
 14 stitches remain,
 turn.

The result is a small gap between the stitches when turning. Always k2tog or p2tog the stitches to the left and right of gap. After k2tog or p2tog, work 1 stitch (knit if on the right side, purl if on the wrong side).
 Work the heel turn until 20 stitches remain.

Knit across and divide the 20 stitches, 10 stitches on Needle 4 and 10 stitches on Needle 1.

Needle 1= pick up 17 heel flap edge stitches. (27 stitches)
 Work across Needle 2 and 3 (Chart 2 – begin round 17)
 Needle 4= pick up 17 heel flap edge stitches. (27 stitches)

Gusset:

In the next round, knit the 17 picked up stitches through the back loop to avoid a hole.

Needle 1= 10 stocking sts (knit stitches), 17 stitches knit through back loop
 Needle 2= The pattern continues on Chart 2 – Round 18
 Needle 3= The pattern continues on Chart 2 – Round 18
 Needle 4=17 stitches knit through back loop, 10 stocking sts (knit stitches)

Work one round even then start gusset.

Needle 1= 27 stitches
 Needle 2+3 (instep) = per Needle 17 stitches = 34 stitches together
 Needle 4= 27 stitches

Work the gusset decrease every other row until you have 64 stitches total.

Gusset Decrease:

Needle 1= knit to last 3 stitches, knit two together, knit 1
Needle 4= knit 1, knit two together through back loop, knit to end of needle.

Knit to desired foot length minus toe.



Toe:

It does not matter which style toe you knit.

Tip: I calculate the toe length (the number of rounds to complete the toe). So I always have the correct length of sock.

How to decrease stitches:

Needle 1/3 = knit to last 3 stitches, knit two together, knit 1

Needle 2/4 = Knit 1, knit the second and third stitch together through the back loop.

64 stitches / 22 Rounds for Toe

Needle 1/4 = 17 stitches

Needle 2/3 = 14 stitches

- 1. decrease → only Needle 1+4
- 1 x decrease 4. row → only Needle 1+4
- 1 x decrease 3. row → only Needle 1+4
- 1 x decrease 3. row → now all Needles
- 3 x decrease 2. row
- 5 x decrease each row = 4 stitches per needle

Knit one round and at the same time decrease the middle 2 (by purl two together) of the 4 stitches on each side band of the toe = 14 stitches left

You will have 7 stitches on the instep and 7 stitches on sole. Kitchener stitch the instep stitches to the sole stitches.

Picot-Crochet border on cuffs (crochet Needle 2 – 2.5 mm)

Picot crochet = single crochets stitch,
* 3 chain stitch (working into chain spaces),
slip stitch,
1 stitch pass by (the cuff should be elastic)
crochet a single crochets stitch into the second stitch *
at * repeat

The „three drop of blood“

Die „**drei Blutstropfen**“ in cable pattern on the Leg are embroidered in the stitch down.
