



„MondKristall“ by Micha Klein (Wolletraum)

(MoonCrystal)

4-ply Sockyarn (100 grams = 420 meters), Needle 2,25 mm (when loosely knit, or 2.5 mm if knit tightly) for German size 39. The length of the foot is adjustable. To change sizes, knit with smaller or larger needle or with more or less stitches (purl or knit).

Tip: Use a stitch marker at the beginning of the round.

Heel Turn: Chart 4b

Right Side Row: Knit 18 stitches / knit 2 together through back loop / knit 1 / leave 12 unworked / turn

Wrong Side Row: 12 stitches remain on right needle / Slip 1 purlwise / purl 2 / purl 2 together (only this once - not the next rows) / purl 2 together / purl 1 / 12 stitches remain / turn

The result is a small gap between the stitches when turning. Always k2tog or p2tog the stitches to the left and right of gap. After k2tog or p2tog, work 1 stitch (knit if on the right side, purl if on the wrong side).

Work the heel turn until 18 stitches remain.

Knit across and divide the 18 stitches, 9 stitches on Needle 4 and 9 stitches on Needle 1.

Pick up stitches and gusset: Chart 5b + Chart 5b

needle 1= pick up 17 heel flap edge stitches. (=26 stitches) (Chart 5a – round 1)

work across needle 2 (= 17 stitches) (Chart 5b – round 1)

work across needle 3 (= 16 stitches) (Chart 5b – round 1)

needle 4= pick up 17 heel flap edge stitches. (=26 stitches) (Chart 5a – round 1)

Gusset:

needle 1= knit 9 stitches, 16 stitches knit through back loop, purl the back of the stitch (Chart 5a –round 2)

needle 2= the pattern continues on (Chart 5b – round 2)

needle 3= the pattern continues on (Chart 5b – round 2)

needle 4= purl the back of the stitch, 16 stitches knit through back loop, knit 9 stitches (Chart 5a – round 2)

Work one round even then start gusset. (Chart 5a+5b – round 3)

Work the gusset decrease every other row until you have 64 stitches total.

Gusset Decrease:

needle 1= knit to last 4 stitches, knit two together, knit 1, purl 1

needle 4= purl 1, knit 1, knit two together through back loop, knit to end of needle.

needle 1 = 26 stitches (10 x decrease one stitches for gusset= 16 stitches

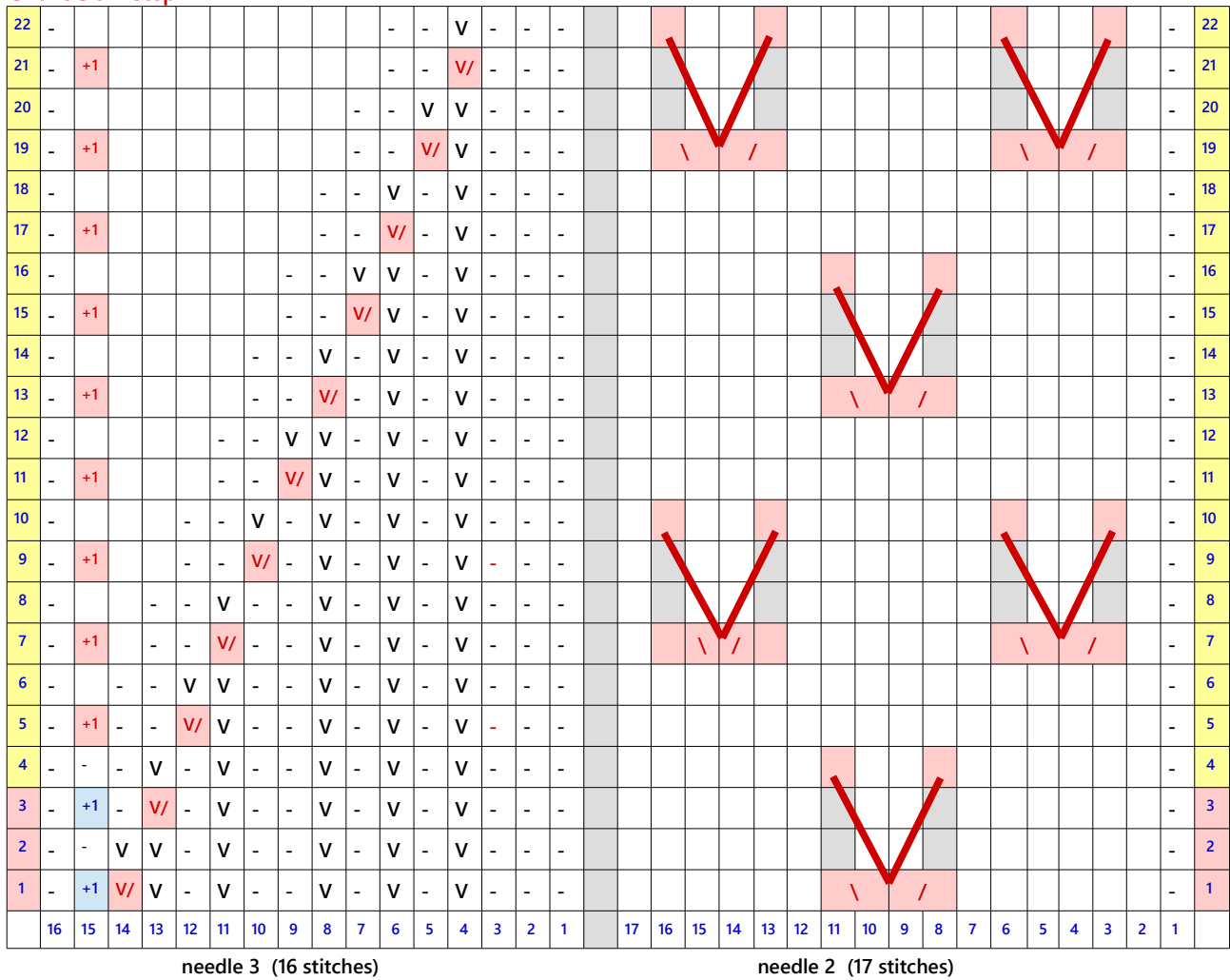
needle 2 (instep) = 17 stitches

needle 3 (instep) = 16 stitches

needle 4 = 26 stitches (10 x decrease one stitches for gusset= 16 stitches

Gusset knit 22 round, sole of foot only stocking stitch.

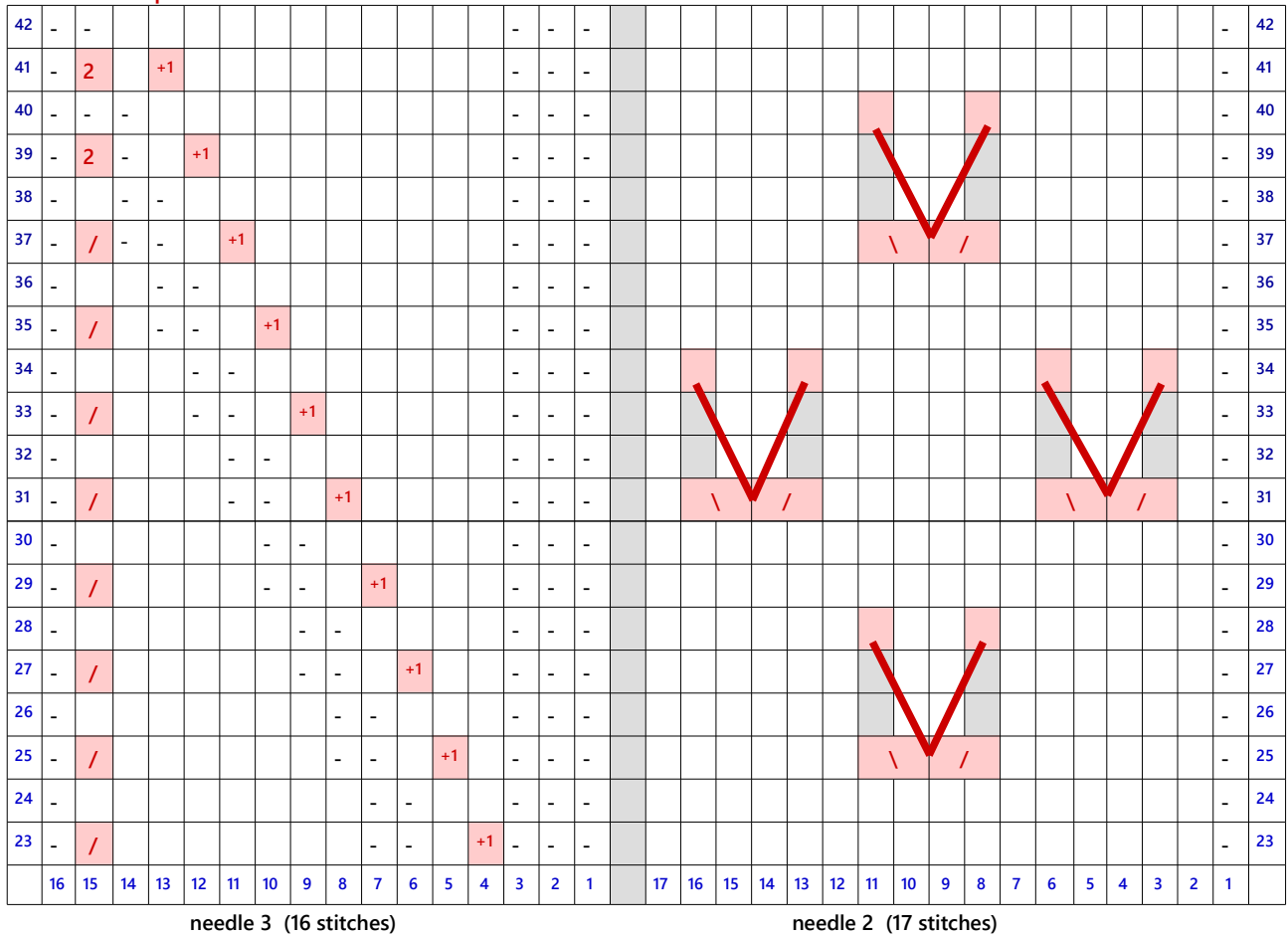

Toe: Chart 8a + Chart 8b

It does not matter which style toe you knit.

Tip: I calculate the toe length (the number of rounds to complete the toe). So I always have the correct length of sock.

How to decrease stitches:

Needle 1/3= knit to last 3 stitches, knit two together, knit 1

Needle 2/4 = Knit 1, ssk (slip, slip, knit = slip the two stitches separately knitwise, insert the left-hand needle point through the fronts of the slopped stitchem the left, and knit them together from this position

64 stitches / 22 rounds for toe

16 stitches per needle (needle 3 = 1 stitch to needle 2)

decrease in rounds:

1. decrease

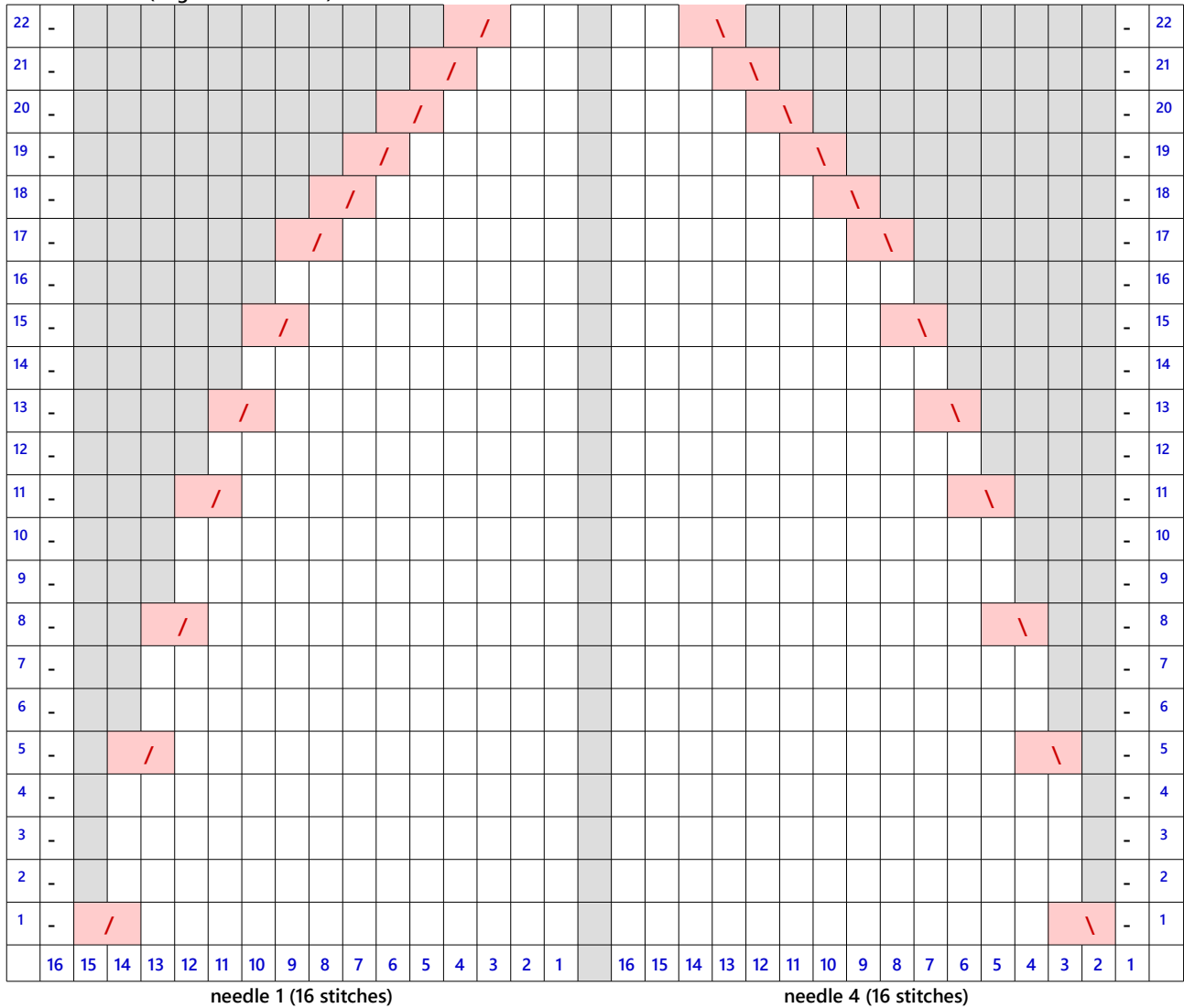

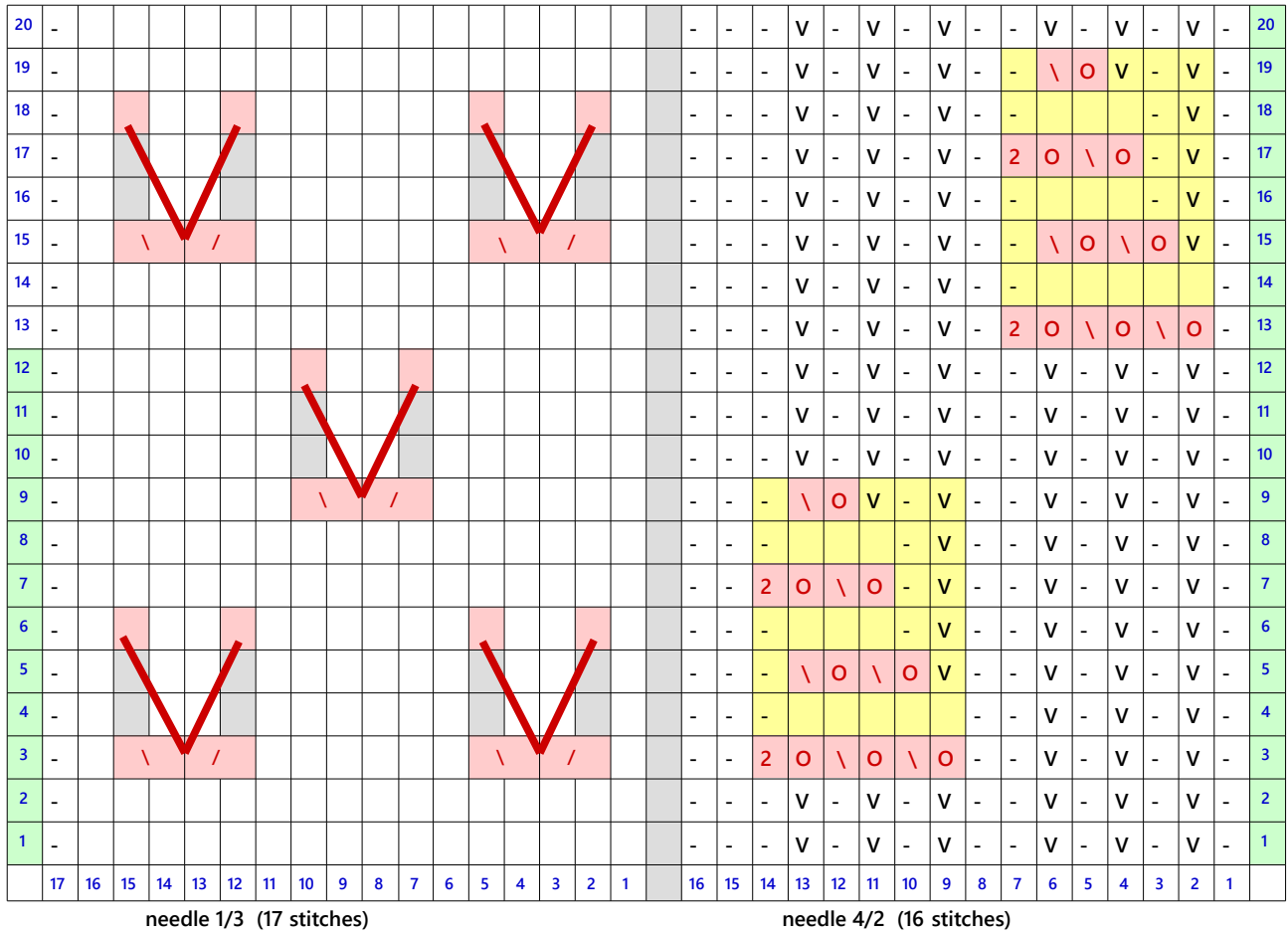

Step by step (example for Chart 2):
 3rd round the 3.+4. stitch k2tog and the 5.+6. stitch ssk (slip-slip-knit = slip the two stitches separately knitwise insert the left-hand needle point through the fronts of the sloped stitches the left and knit them together from this position)
 The next 2 rounds knit with 2 stitches (4.+5.) not like before 4 stitches (3./4./5./6.).
 The next round before 4. stitches make one stitch by picking up the horizontal loop between stitches the 2nd round of the underlying (with right needle 2 rounds deep in the gap between the two pairs of knitted together - that is the 2nd horizontal loop between stitches on the left needle - and pull through a loop.
 The loop hold with the right thumb, the next two stitches (4.+5.) knit.
 With the left needle through the back hole (right needle) prick and with the right needle in front into the hole and get the next loop.
 Both loop are right and left of stitches 4.+5. (not too tight knit !).

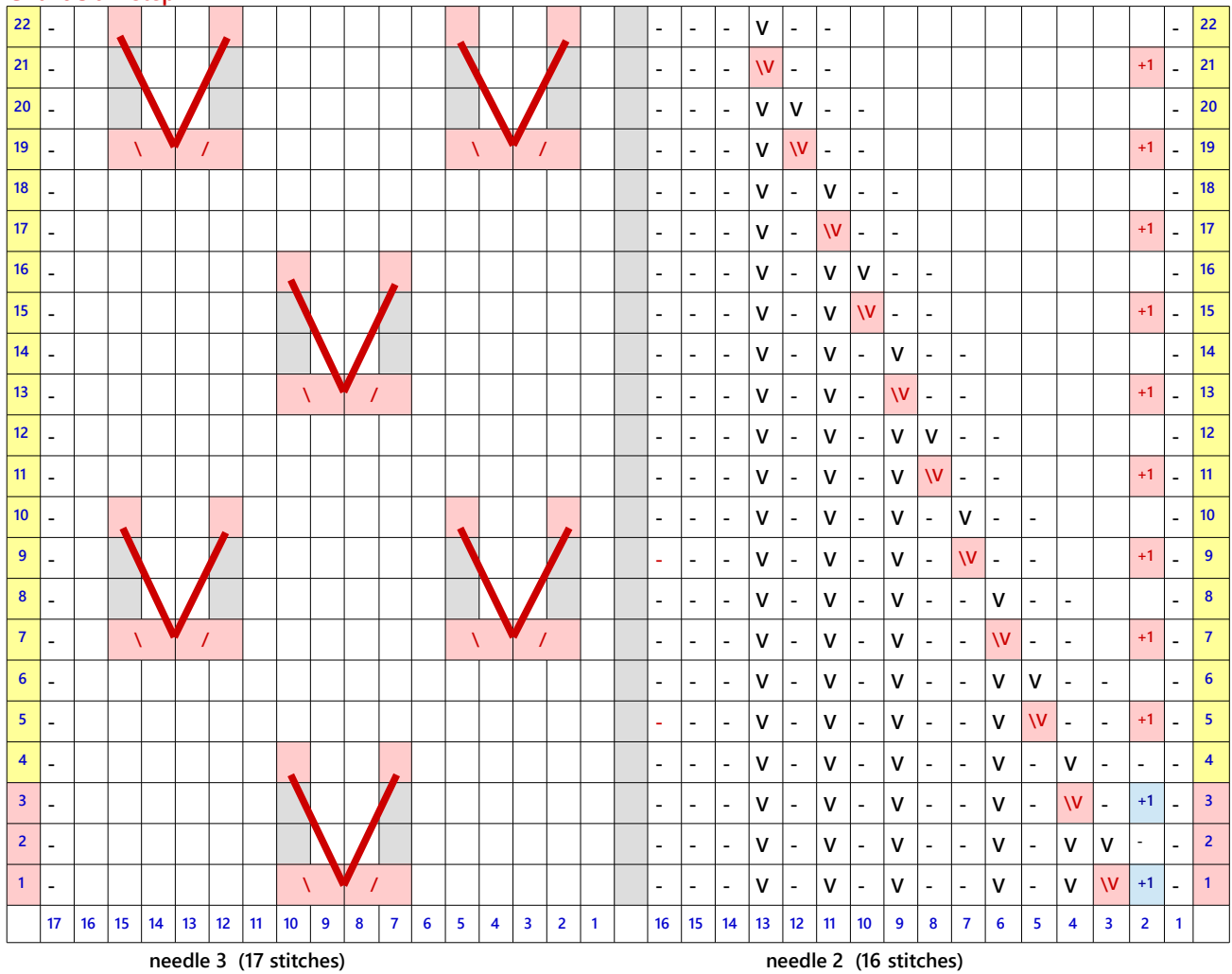

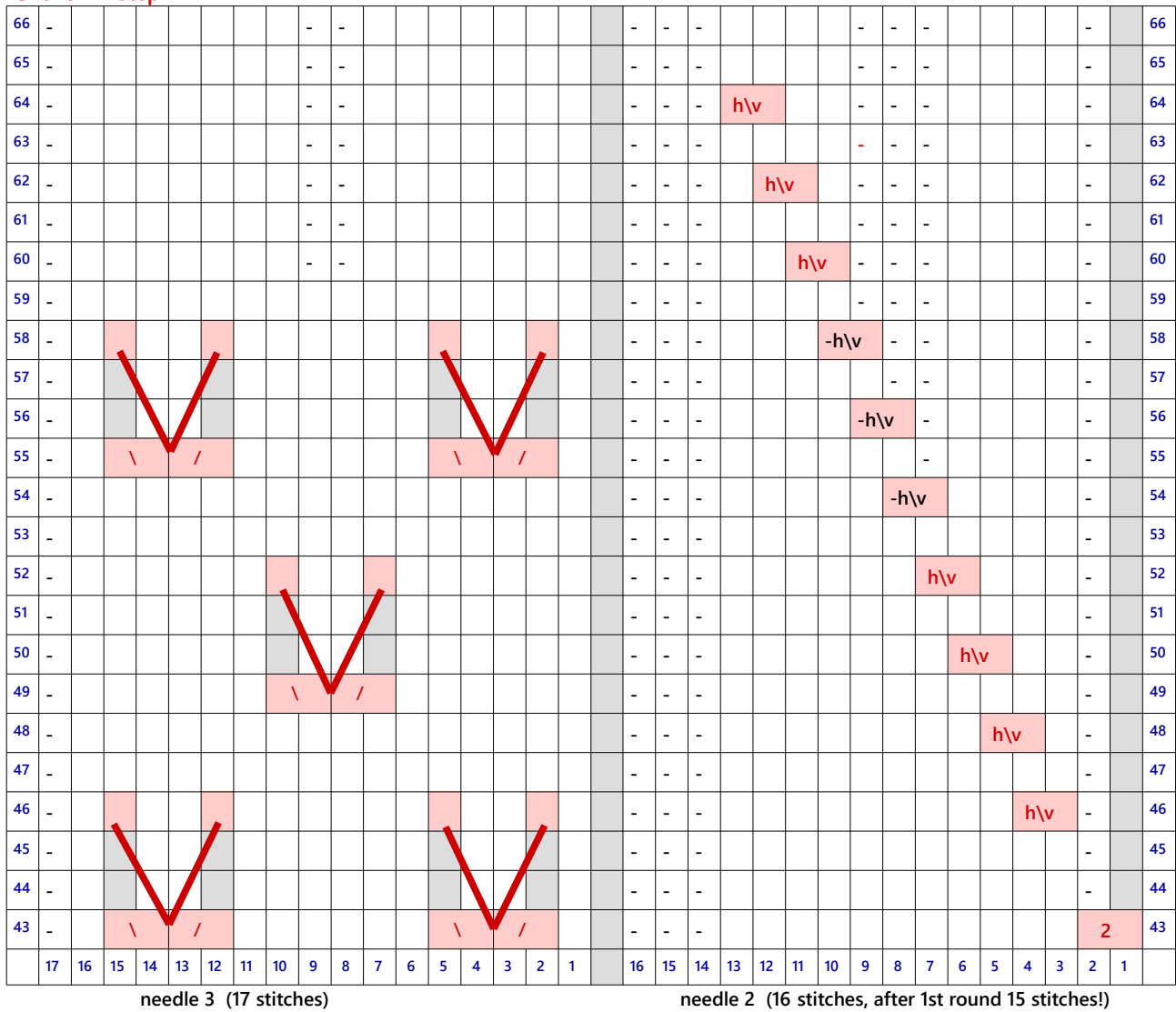

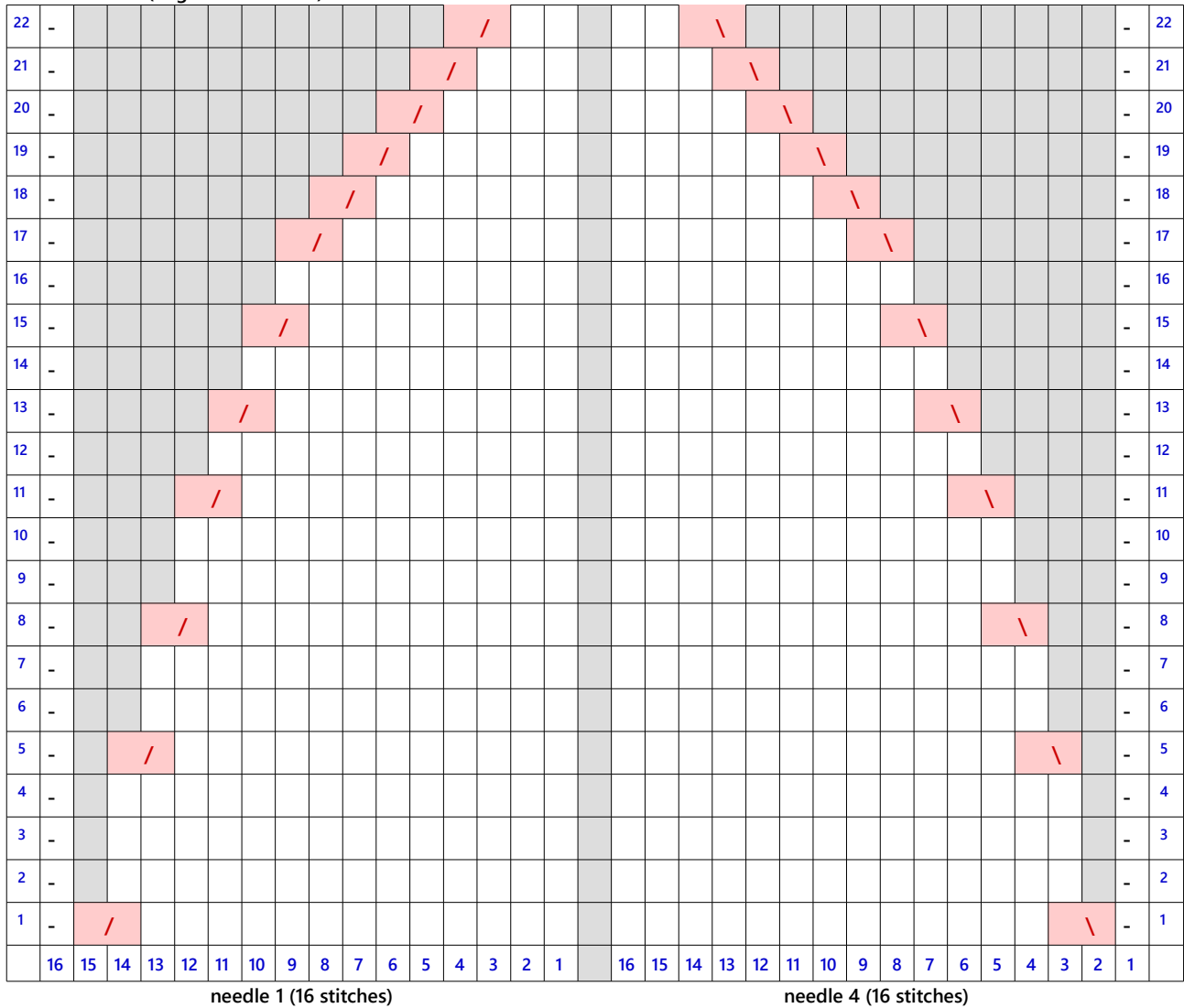
