

## "Glänzende DrachenSchuppe - Handstulpen" by Micha Klein (Wolletraum) ("Shiny DragonScale - Fingerless")

4-ply Sockyarn (100 grams = 420 meters), Needle 2,25 mm (when loosely knit, or 2.5 mm if knit tightly) for German size 7 (= 19 cm hand circumference)

To change sizes, knit with smaller or larger needle or with more or less stitches (purl or knit).

from the cuffs to thumb increase: Chart 1

64 stitches / 16 stitches per needle

Cuff: knit round 1 and 20 x round 2 = 21 rounds

Wrist: 8 x knit round 1-4 = 32 rounds

Legend for Chart 1 + Chart 2											
	knit	-	purl								
V	klb (knit into back loop of the stitch) no stitch										
W	insert the needle knitwise into the stitch, wrap the thread twice around the needle and knit										
//\\	Slip the 4 stitches on the right needle, at the same time drop the wrapped thread.  Then insert with the left needle into 2.+ 1. stitches on the right needle and slip over the 3. + 4. stitches and the 4.+3. stitches slip on the left needle. Knit this 4 stitches.  Wrist: 8 x knit round 1-4 = 32 rounds										
1 - 4											
1 + 2	Cuff: knit round 1 and 20 x round 2 = 21 rounds										
Z	make one stitch by picking up the horizontal loop between stitches and knitting into the back of it( the increased stitches are highlighted in red)										
13 M mit Zopf	13 stitches cable needle 4 and needle 1										






## Thumb increase: Chart 2

needle 4+1 = each needle with 16 stitches, each needle increase 10 stitches = 26 stitches each needle 4+1 If the thumb is to wide, stop the increase earlier!

Chart 2 (begin with needle 4) needle 2+3 the pattern Chart 1.



needle 1 (13 M thumb increase / 13 M cable) needle 4 (13 M thumb increase / 13 M cable)

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stitches per needle 1 + needle 4 = 26 stitches
stitches per needle 2 + needle 3 = 16 stitches

24 thumb-stitches slip on one or two a safety-pins.

needle 4 = from the beginning of the needle stitch 15 - 26 (= 12 stitches)

--> in Chart 2 it is the stitch 2 - 13

needle 1 = from the beginning of the needle stitch 1 - 12 (= 12 stitches)

--> in Chart 2 it is the stitch 1 - 12
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Total 84 stitches minus 24 thumb-stitches = 60 stitches
The 60 stitches for the palm knit 8 more rounds (Chart 1 rounds 1-4) - attention to the pattern! knit 15 rounds cuff-pattern (Chart 1= 15 x round 2) or the length you want.
Ending with needle 4 and bind off all stitches (knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches).

The 26 thumb-stitches from the safety-pin share out to 3 or 4 needles beginning from forefinger: knit 1, \*(purl 2, knit 2) - \*repeat, knit 1

Pick up 4 stitches from the edge of the forefinger, the next round knit 1, purl 2, knit 1

For the thumb knit 13 rounds with ribs and bind off the stitches (knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches).

Below the thumb sew on 3 little buttons.
