

Fauler Zauber by Micha Klein

Socks with cable and kbl (knit from back of loop) stitches at cuff and heal.

Knitting in round from cuff to toe. The chart for the right and the left sock is different.

The pattern is very much interwoven with the interlaced stitches. To create it not be overstretched, you need in these areas more stitches - but then these are reduced again.

Size

38-39

dimensions unstretched: cuff ca. 16cm, Leg ca. 20 cm, foot ca. 25 cm, gusset to heel ca. 13 cm, heel width ca. 7,5 cm,

foot width ca. 10 cm (these dimensions obtained with the 4-ply sock wool used *Frau Odersocke*)

start with 71 stitches, later reduced to 67 stitches

The width can be changed with needle size more ore less or with knit one more stitch per needle like pattern more or less.

Knit the foot length you need.

Material

100 gram sockyarn 4-ply (100 g = 420 m)

dpl 2,25 mm or 2,5 mm (needle 1+4 = heel / needle 2+3 = foot)

stitchmarker for start of round, scissors, wool needle for sewing, sock jewelry if you want

Pattern

ribbing with kbl

cable

Heel Turn:

RS: k 22 / k2tog-b / k1 / 14 st remain on the left needle / turn

WS: slip 14 st remain on the right needle / sl1 / p6 / p2tog / p1 / 14 st remain on the left needle / turn

The result is a small gap between the stitches when turning. The stitch on the right and left of the gap knit or purl together to work the heel.

Then knit or purl the next stitch. Turn continue knitting short rows until 23 st remain.

needle 4= k10 / 11.+12. st k2tog-b

needle 1= k11

If using magic Loop, place a marker between stitch 10 and 11 to mark the beginning of the round. If using two cable needles, arrange stitches so that the instep stitches are on one cable needle and the gusset and heel stitches are on the other cable needle.

Gusset: (instep, continue following Chart 1 and sole stockinette stitch)

1st Round Needle 1 = knit 10 stitches, pick up 17 stitches from the heel flap-edge (= 27 stitches)

Cast on and gusset:**1. Round**

Nd 1 = k11, pick up 16 st from the heel flap-edge (= 27 M)

Nd 2 = st st (= 16 M) (chart 1a rd 4)

Nd 3 = according to pattern (= 19 M) (chart 1a rd 4)

Nd 4 = pick up 16 st from the heel flap-edge, k11 (= 27 M)

2. Round

Nd 1 = k11, 16 kbl

Nd 2 = st st (chart 1a rd 5)

Nd 3 = according to pattern (chart 1a rd 5)

Nd 4 = 16 kbl, k11

Foot top knit according to pattern, foot sole stockinette stitch.

The instep according to pattern (chart 1a – attention to pattern)

Knit another round with no decreases, then start with gusset decrease.

Knit the foot length you need to the beginning of the toe.

The number of rows (you can see it next under toe) gives the number of centimeters, that must be subtracted from the required foot length.

Gusset-decrease: 14x jede 2. rd gusset decrease for nd 1+4 = 13 st per nd
 nd 1 = 3.+ 2. last st ktog
 nd 4 = 2.+3. ssk

Toe:

according to pattern

61 st / 25 rd

Toe-decrease: nd 1+3 = 3.+2. last st ktog
nd 2+4 = 2.+3. st ssk

1 st from nd 3 slip to nd 2

nd 1+4 = je 13 st

nd 2 = 17 st

nd 3 = 18 st

Following decrease in round:

1. dec -----> only nd 3

1 x dec 4. rd --> only nd 2+3

2 x dec 3. rd -----> only nd 2+3

2 x dec 2. rd -----> only nd 2+3

1 x dec 2. rd -----> each nd

8 x dec each rd = per nd 4 st remain

This 16 stitches with kitchener stitch sew together.

Right Sock

Cuff and leg / Chart 1a + 1b

71 st cast on

30 rd knit ribbing for cuff (chart rd 1-30)

51 rd knit leg pattern (chart nd 1+4= knit 1x rd 1+2, then knit 49x re 2)

(chart nd 2+3= knit 2x rd 1-24i, knit 1x rd 2-4)

Heel flap

nd 1+4 = 32 st + 7 st (make st by picking up the horizontal loop between sts and knitting into the back of it) = 39 st

knit 30 row
